Pásky s.r.o. hereby declares that the printed adhesive tapes described above comply with the requirements of Article 5 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 of the European Parliament and of the Council on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR) with respect to substances of concern, to the best of our knowledge and on the basis of technical documentation held by us and available to competent authorities upon request.

Pásky s.r.o. is not a manufacturer of chemical substances. When assessing compliance with chemical requirements, we rely on verified declarations and laboratory test reports from our suppliers and on detailed knowledge of our own production processes.

Notes

1. This declaration covers substance-level compliance under PPWR Article 5 for the material inputs of the products described above. Pásky s.r.o. maintains technical documentation substantiating this declaration, which is available to competent national market surveillance authorities upon request. Supporting documentation includes the EU Declaration of Conformity and Technical File issued by MAC Autoadesivi S.R.L. (Declaration No. PPWR-02, 02.07.2026, Rev. 0) pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2025/40, Annex VIII.
2. Saturated paper tape with natural rubber and hydrocarbon resin adhesive is a paper-based product. For its intended use in sealing cardboard packaging, the paper backing is mechanically separated before the pulping stage and does not adversely affect the recycling process of paper and cardboard (INGEDE Method 12 certified). The paper core is manufactured from 100% post-consumer recycled cardboard.
3. Recyclability assessment grades (A–E) under PPWR Article 6 cannot be assigned at this stage, as the harmonised Design for Recycling criteria and delegated acts of the European Commission are expected to be published by 2028. The supplier has carried out a preliminary recyclability assessment using INGEDE Method 12 and has committed to updating the assessment within six months of publication of the applicable delegated acts.
4. Independent laboratory quantification of PFAS pursuant to an EU-accredited measurement methodology is not yet available, as the Commission has not yet published the harmonised test method. The supplier has determined PFAS concentration at < 1 ppm by existing laboratory analysis. This declaration will be supplemented with further laboratory test reports upon availability of an accredited EU protocol.
5. Pásky s.r.o. undertakes to notify its customers without delay of any changes to material composition, chemical formulation, or upstream suppliers that affect the accuracy of this declaration, in accordance with PPWR Annex VII.
