Pásky s.r.o. hereby declares that the printed paper adhesive tapes described above comply with the requirements of Article 5 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 of the European Parliament and of the Council on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR) with respect to substances of concern, to the best of our knowledge and on the basis of technical documentation held by us and available to competent authorities upon request.

Pásky s.r.o. is not a manufacturer of chemical substances. When assessing compliance with chemical requirements, we rely on verified declarations from our suppliers and on detailed knowledge of our own production processes.

Notes

1. This declaration covers substance-level compliance under PPWR Article 5 for the products described above. Pásky s.r.o. maintains technical documentation substantiating this declaration, including the EU Declaration of Conformity No. 012/2026 (31.07.2026) issued by the substrate manufacturer pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2025/40. This documentation is available to competent national market surveillance authorities upon request.
2. The paper backing of the tape is siliconised (release-coated). The product consists of siliconised paper, hot-melt synthetic rubber adhesive and printing inks. This multi-component structure means that recyclability depends on the availability of appropriate separation processes. The substrate manufacturer has committed to carrying out recyclability testing as soon as the delegated acts establishing the Design for Recycling criteria under PPWR Article 6 are published.
3. With respect to PFAS: the product is not intended for food contact. The substrate manufacturer declares that raw materials do not contain intentionally added PFAS; however, the presence of PFAS in trace amounts as a result of raw material characteristics cannot be excluded. Independent laboratory quantification pursuant to an EU-accredited measurement methodology is not yet available, as the Commission has not yet published the harmonised test method.
4. Recyclability assessment grades (A–E) under PPWR Article 6 cannot be assigned at this stage, as the harmonised Design for Recycling criteria and delegated acts of the European Commission are expected to be published by 2028. The assessment will be updated within six months of publication of the applicable delegated acts.
5. Pásky s.r.o. undertakes to notify its customers without delay of any changes to material composition, chemical formulation, or upstream suppliers that affect the accuracy of this declaration, in accordance with PPWR Annex VII.

This declaration is issued in good faith on the basis of information available at the date of issue. It does not constitute a legally binding guarantee of conformity of the finished packaged product placed on the market by the customer. The manufacturer of the finished product retains full responsibility for compliance under Article 15 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40. The content of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) in printed paper adhesive tape with hot-melt synthetic rubber adhesive complies with the requirements of Article 5 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40. Verification was conducted based on written declarations from suppliers of raw materials confirming that PFAS are not intentionally added to any material component. The substrate manufacturer additionally notes that, given the characteristics of certain raw materials, the presence of PFAS in trace amounts cannot be entirely excluded; however, PFAS are not deliberately used in the formulation of any component of this product. A total fluorine screening of the finished product had not been performed at the time this declaration was issued, as the European Commission had not yet published a harmonized, accredited methodology for measuring PFAS in packaging materials in accordance with the PPWR. This declaration will be supplemented with the results of laboratory testing immediately upon the publication of the relevant methodology.
